I would like to thank all our families for your continued support with the Covid-19 home testing programme.

### Home Testing

As you are aware, the twice weekly home testing has continued in order to support our families, staff and our community. This process will remain in place, for those who wish to take part, until the end of the summer term.

### **Please ask your child to conduct the tests on the following dates:**

PLEASE remember; should your child's the LFD test be positive; it is important that they immediately self-isolate and book a PCR test. Other family members in the household and close contacts should also self-isolate, pending the result of the PCR test, in line with Government Guidance. Please report the positive LFD result to Eleanor Evans, Operations Manager on **07718 162761 immediately**. Do not wait until start of school the next day. We are working with the Local Authority to ensure all symptomatic or asymptomatic children who have received a positive LFD test, are isolating. Should a child be identified as breaching this government guidance, the Local Authority will be advised.

Children cannot attend school until a negative result has been received. If your child returns to school BEFORE we have had sight of a negative result, students will be removed from class and be seated in a separate, well ventilated area until we can contact parents/carers to obtain clarification of the PCR test.

### Vaccinations Update

#### Walk in vaccinations (Shrewsbury)

The NHS are going to be running walk-in vaccination clinics at the Shrewsbury Bowls Centre, Sundorne Road, Shrewsbury SY1 4RQ

#### **For people aged 40 and over (Astra Zeneca 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses)**

Tuesday 22nd June 8.30am – 1pm

Sunday 27th June 8.30am – 1pm

**For 18-39 year olds (Pfizer 1<sup>st</sup> doses)**

Wednesday 23rd June 8.30am – 1pm

Sunday 4th July – 8.30am – 7pm

81% of adults in Shropshire have received their first vaccination and 64% have received their second. This is incredible data and with the vaccinations now being rolled out to the over 18-year olds, we hope this will see these numbers rise swiftly.
