

Dear Parents and Carers,

Due to a rise in the number of positive Covid-19 cases at the school, we have held discussions with Public Health Shropshire and the Local Authority. As a result, we will be taking the following steps from Monday 4th October 2021, to reduce further spread of the virus.

- All students must wear facemasks inside the building, in corridors and all communal spaces. This includes, but not limited to, walking between classes, the dining room and toilets. Please ensure you send your child into school with a suitable facemask each day.
- There will not be an expectation for students to wear facemasks in lessons. However, any student wishing to wear one, can do so.
- All students must always wear facemasks on school transport, buses and taxis and on any extracurricular activities when school minibus travel is required.
- All students must sanitise their hands upon entrance and exit to classrooms, and in public spaces.
- Facemasks should be worn correctly, covering both the nose and mouth.
- We strongly advise that all students continue to complete two lateral flow tests at home per week.

We took 15 girls from our football team who thoroughly enjoyed taking selfies with the trophy, this was then followed with a game at the town ground.
