As part of their Digital Design unit, Year 9 students at Shrewsbury Academy embarked on an exciting project to create unique cupcake box logos for a fictional brand. This hands-on experience introduced them to key design principles such as digital illustration, typography, colour theory, and branding.


Students used a range of tools including Microsoft Paint, Adobe Photoshop Elements, and most notably Wacom drawing tablets, which are widely recognised as the industry standard for professional graphic designers. These tablets allowed students to experiment with precision and creativity, simulating real-world design workflows.

Whether working with a stylus on a tablet or using a standard mouse, students demonstrated impressive creativity and technical skill. Their final logos ranged from playful and pastel to sleek and minimalist, reflecting a strong understanding of brand identity.
