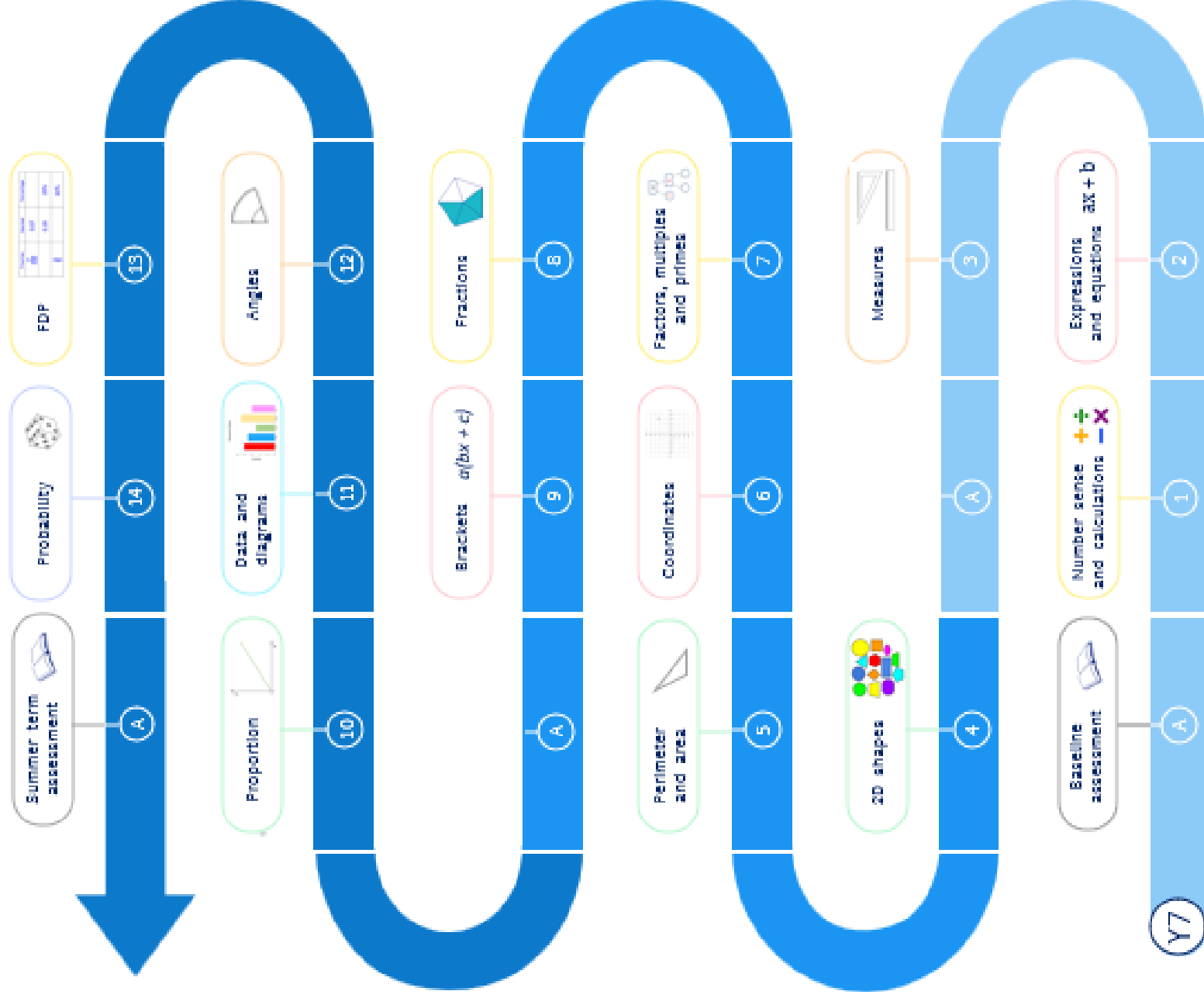


Maths

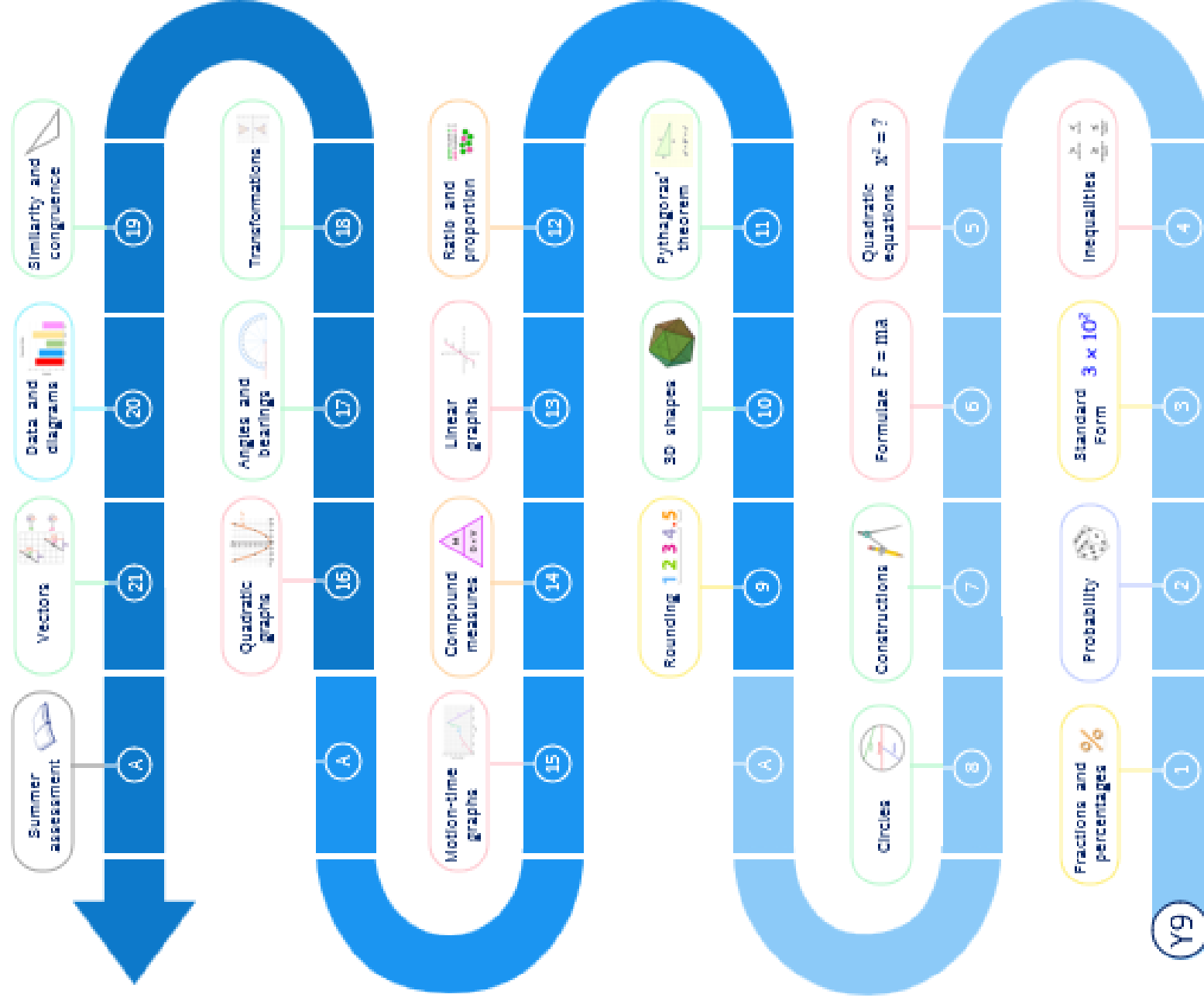
