Uniform

Students should wear their **school PE kit** for transition days.

Start time entrance

Students should arrive at the **gate opposite the Lantern Centre** at **9.00am**. Members of the SEN team will be waiting here to welcome Year 6's. Look out for Shrewsbury Academy SEN staff and student Ambassadors with **Thumbs up** signs at the gate. They will help you get to where you need to be. Year 6 students will be taken to line up at **9.00am**. **Children will need to be picked up from the gate opposite the lantern at 3:00pm**
